#### Create a Voice Message Options

Voice Mail asks you to record the message after the tone.

When you are finished, dial # or hang up.

Either action disconnects your call and stores the message in the "New" messages folder.

#### Record a message/greeting

Voice Mail asks you to record the message after the tone.

After the tone say your message, and then press the # key.

Voice Mail gives you these options:

- 1 Accept this recording
- 2 -Listen to the recording
- 3 To re-record your message

#### Change your Password

Voice Mail asks you to enter your new password followed by #.

Enter your new password, and #.

Voice Mail asks you to re-enter your new password followed by #.

Enter your new password and # again.

Voice Mail confirms that your password has been changed, and returns you to the Voice Mail Box options.

#### Voice Mail Retrieval

\* From your subscribed phone Pick up the handset.

Dial \*98, then follow the prompts

\* From any other location Pick up the handset and dial your home phone number.

When you hear your recording push the \* key.

When prompted for your mailbox number enter your 10 digit phone number.

Listen for the prompt for your password.

Enter your password.

Default Password is your 10 Digit
Phone Number

#### Voice Mail Message Controls

- 1 Interrupt message introduction
- \* Rewind the message by 3 seconds
- #-Forward the message by 3 seconds

- 5 Repeat the current message
- 6 Play the next message
